

A campaign to eliminate our debt and move forward with spirit

This fall, St. Margaret's is launching a coordinated campaign to imagine our future and secure the resources to achieve it.

For the past several years, the cost of servicing the debt remaining from the construction of our sanctuary has consumed a huge part of our budget. Despite our best efforts to restructure the debt, reduce operating costs and bring in rental income, we struggle to break even. These financial constraints limit our ability to minister to members and spread God's love to others.

We owe \$1.38 million. This translates into bond payments of \$3,000 a week for the next 13 years. Imagine what we could do if we eliminated the debt and could devote an additional \$3,000 a week to ministry!

To prayerfully contemplate God's will, we have launched this campaign with an all-church bible study, followed by a series of small group bible studies. In October, we'll hold informal "Imagine Gatherings" in homes and at the church to engage every member of the parish in a conversation about our future. In November, we'll ask you to make separate financial commitments to meet our annual operating expenses and, over a three-year period, eliminate the debt.

Why now?

With the nation's economy in the doldrums, this may seem to be an odd time to launch a campaign to reduce debt and expand ministry. The vestry chose to do this now for three reasons:

- 1. Because of the debt payments, we cannot sustain our current levels of staffing or ministry.
- We have already taken all other possible steps to increase our income and reduce our expenses. Reducing the debt is the only way—other than cutting staffing to unacceptable levels—to put ourselves on a sustainable financial footing.
- We believe that given the choice, the St. Margaret's community would rather reach out in faith than hunker down in doubt.

To help us reach out, the vestry hired a consultant, Marc Rieke from the Enrichment Group. As the vestry has come to know Marc and learned of his experience advising other churches in similar circumstances, they have grown confident that this campaign is the right action at the right time.

But the success of the campaign depends not on the consultant, but on you. What you do to hear God's voice, contribute to the vision, volunteer in the campaign, and ultimately make a financial commitment can make this campaign transformative. Please give prayerful consideration to the invitations you will receive to participate.

We know that St. Margaret's can be even more than it is today. Through your dedication and commitment, we sustain lively ministries, but how much more could we do with proper resources and more support? We want to grow into what God intends for us. We are poised on the brink of a brighter future, but it will take all of us working together to get there.
